Genesis 3:1-13; 11:1-9

1. In verses 1 to 5, in what ways does the snake (a) quote God correctly, (b) twist what God said in Genesis 2:16-17 or (c) contradict what God said?
2. In verses 2-3, how does Eve (a) quote God correctly or (b) exaggerate what God actually said in chapter 2: 16-17?
3. Can you think of ways in which we distort what God says to us or exaggerate what God says to us?
4. What makes Eve want the fruit - v 6?
5. How are Adam and Eve different towards God after eating the fruit (vv 7-13)?
6. How are Adam and Eve different towards each other after eating the fruit?
7. How are Adam and Eve different towards the natural world after eating the fruit?
8. God details various negative consequences for Adam, Eve and the natural world in verses 14-24. What are they?
9. What signs are there that God continues to plan to bless human beings?
10. Looking at verse 15, how might that verse be a foretaste of the New Testament?
