1. As you look at the passage, which words keep cropping up? What is the frequency with which they appear telling us?
2. Genesis 1:1 - 2:3 contains phrases which keep cropping up. What phrases keep being repeated and what do you think they mean?
3. When God sees each part of creation and calls it 'good' or 'very good', what are the implications for how we treat the earth?
4. Verses 26 and 27 speak of humans being made in the 'image' of God. What do you think this says about human beings?
5. In verses 2 and 3 of Chapter 2, God 'rested'. What do you think 'rested' means? What do you think these verses imply for human conduct?
