Worship

Word

1. Read Ch 1:1-12. Job is best understood as a parable. Do you agree?
2. What do you think Satan means in 1:9-11?
3. Read Ch 4:7-8 Each of Job's friends says roughly the same thing—that suffering is a result of sin. Now read Ch 42:7-9 - what do these vs tell us about how God sees things?
4. How might we speak well to people who are suffering?
5. Amongst Job's despair we find glimmers of hope—Ch19:25-26. Now read Hebrews 12:2—how does keep our eyes fixed on Jesus help us walk through difficult seasons?
5. Read Psalm 23—the bible talks a lot about walking—what helps you

If you can, make time this week to go on a prayer walk around your neighbourhood.

As you walk pray for the homes and places you pass thinking specifically of those who are suffering and struggling with Covid or other kinds of difficulty or challenge.
